# Game Definitions

## Salt & Pepper

Count odd holes on the front and even holes on the back and then subtract ½ of your handicap.

## Shamble

- This is a two-person format
- Both players hit drives
- Then each player takes their 2nd shot by hitting their partner's drive ball
- The best of the 2nd shots is then selected to continue playing the hole.
- From the best of the 2nd shot, the partners play alternating shots into the hole.
- The player whose second shot was picked up, plays the third shot, then alternate until ball is holed out.
- 60% of lower handicap will be used plus 40% of the higher handicap to come up with team handicap

## Cha Cha Cha

- On the first hole, you count the best net ball of the foursome
- On the second hole, you count the best TWO net balls of the foursome
- On the third hole, you count the best THREE net balls of the foursome
- Repeat on fourth hole (counting the best net ball of the foursome, and so on)

## 2 Person Best Ball (choose your partner)

- On each hole, the *net* best ball counts for the game.

## Hate 'Em

Before you tee off, circle one hole on each 9 that you hate. At the end of the round subtract the 2 holes that you circled from your gross score and then subtract your full handicap.

## T.E.N. (Individual Game)

Only the holes beginning with the letters T, E, & N are added for your total game score then minus ½ of your handicap. Holes 2,3,8,9,10,11,12,13, & 18

## Scramble

There is one score recorded per hole per team. First, every player hits from the tee, then the best drive is chosen and each player hits her next shot one club length from the chosen ball. On the green, each player will put her ball from within 6 inches of the chosen ball. Each best ball is chosen until the ball is holed.

## 6/6/6

Every 6 holes, the game format changes. During our Member/Member tournament, the 3 games will be as follows:

Holes 1 – 6: 2 person net best ball

Holes 7-12: Alternate Shot (Each partner drives, the two partners choose their preferred drive, then alternate shots into the hole)

Holes 13 – 18: Scramble (Each partner drives, the two partners choose their preferred drive, then play a scramble into the hole)
